HOW TO ENTER

- 1. Go to foodliner.com/pride-ride-submission.
- 2. Enter your **DRIVER ID, NAME, EMAIL** and **TERMINAL LOCATION.**
- 3. Click on the **UPLOAD IMAGE** button to select your photo. Accepted file types: jpeg, jpg, png, gif, bmp.
- 4. Click on the **SUBMIT YOUR ENTRY** button.

TIPS

- Make sure the entire tractor or tractor and trailer is included in the photo.
- Showcase the company logo. Make sure it is not covered up.
- Watch for shadows, power lines, vehicles and other objects in the background.
- Lighting is important. Photos that are too dark or light will not reproduce.
- Suggested mobile phones: Galaxy or iPhone
- Shooting at maximum resolution.
- Camera's setting should be set to at least 5 mega pixels, large picture size, 100% jpg quality.
- Preferred resolution: 300 dpi
- Try to find a clean, nice looking patch of cement or roadway.
- Avoid digital zoom with your cell phone. If you need to get closer, move closer. You will get a much better photo.
- Print your picture as a 8" x 10" to make sure it looks as good printed as it does digitally.
- Be sure to send photos at full resolution. Most phones will resize when emailed, which leads to lower resolution.
